

CallByFace

A licence that locks an ordinary Android phone into one calling screen with six faces and an emergency button.

What the user sees

- Six large faces. One tap calls that person.
- An incoming call fills the screen — the whole photo answers.
- No home screen, no app icons, no notifications to get lost in.
- The phone returns to locked mode automatically.

What the family member controls

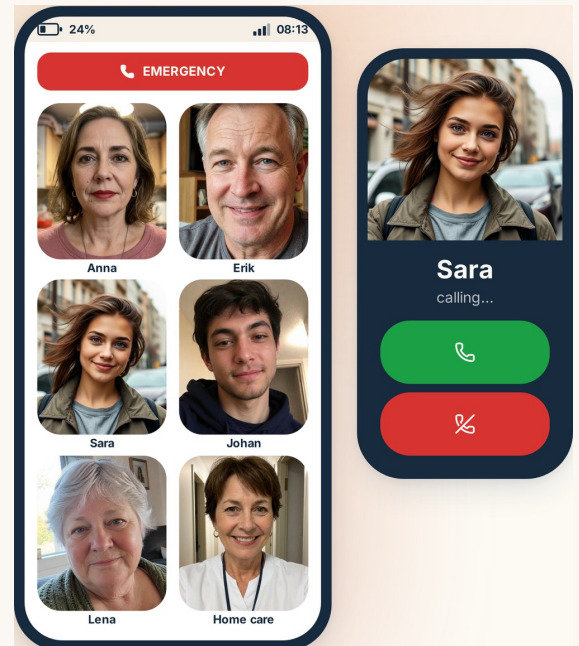
- The admin menu opens with ten taps on the bar at the top.
- Add contacts, names and photos from the phone's gallery.
- Set the emergency number and what the button calls.
- The screen can stay on while the phone is charging.

What CallByFace is not

CallByFace is a consumer product, not a CE-marked medical device: it does not diagnose, treat or monitor vital signs. It is not a personal alarm or monitoring service — in an emergency, call the emergency number in your country. Whether it can be prescribed as an assistive device is decided entirely by the relevant health authority.
